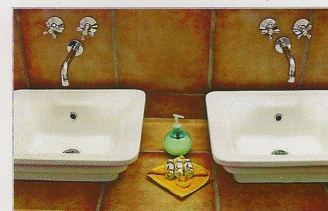
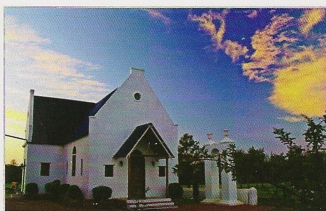




DE WAGENHUIS *Guesthouse*



Experience tranquility and traditional South African hospitality on this picturesque farm

De Wagenhuis Guest House is situated on the historic Rotterdam farm just 8 km's from Swellendam. A working dairy and citrus farm dating back to 1794, this guest house offers seven rooms in the 'Wagenhuis building' and 12 rooms in the new wing. The main 'Wagenhuis building' includes a family apartment with 2 rooms, kitchen and lounge. Other facilities include a large pool, quaint chapel with stained glass windows, lapa, pub and covered braai venue. The new wing includes fully disabled rooms with sophisticated energy saving technology included in the infrastructure.

A large function room which is also the museum, showing many animals found in this region, can seat approximately 70 people. These trophies have been passed down through the family, generation after generation. The museum also houses a tribute to the owners' father who was a



racing car champion in his day. Warm South African hospitality is experienced in every way at this delightful farm-stay. Start the day with a hearty farm-style breakfast prepared with care by the owner's wife. Home-made lunch and dinners are also on offer by prior arrangement.

Farm tours and a visit to the cheese factory can be arranged for a small fee. Discover the gentle life that lies beyond the N2 - this is the perfect introduction to the Garden Route.

Spend some "down-time" in Swellendam, South Africa's third oldest town, visit : *The Bontebok National Park, Hermitage Liqueur Farm*, enjoy a lazy sunset cruise on *Buffelsjachtsdam*, linger at the *Maggy Lismont Gallery* and nearby *Drostdy Museum* and ride the *Two Feathers horse trail*, and did you know that Swellendam is the largest youngberry growing region in the world?
